3	<p>CalHHS 988 Crisis Policy Advisory Group Updates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Goal of developing recommendations to legislature for 5-year implementation plan <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Draft implementation plan by August to surface publicly in September</li> <li>○ HHS starting to meet with grantees starting 5/23 to get thoughts and feedback as well as insight on implementation steps</li> <li>○ Opportunities for public comment in October, supported by webinars</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Desired outcomes: comprehensive 988 system with consistent statewide access, high quality services, coordination across and outside the continuum that serves the needs of all Californians <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Workgroups 1 and 2 have concluded, 988-911-crisis care continuum integration (workgroup 3) ongoing, final meeting in July</li> <li>○ Workgroup 5 started last week, work groups 4 and 6 will open soon – can email Anh Thu if interested in joining</li> <li>○ Meetings are five hours long, next meeting 6/26, virtual option</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Anh Thu Bui

5	<p>Vibrant Updates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chief officer sent out update from SAMHSA conference with network agreement updates this morning</li> <li>• Been in touch with BASHA group and will come for visit in late June</li> <li>• Vibrant spoke with grantees at SAMHSA conference and are planning a smaller regional meeting between California, Arizona, and Nevada to have regional meetings in California in November <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ November 12-14, all 988 centers from those states, tribal grantees, and mental health authorities</li> <li>○ Save the date will be sent in July.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Nancy Hobbins

6	<p>Cal OES/NGA Updates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cal OES is preparing a review of topics to be sent out in a June email communication and presentation. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CRM contract</li> <li>Allowable equipment in reference to budget</li> <li>988 Supplemental funding beyond the 988 system</li> <li>988 direct vs. reimbursement, OES forms for annual funding</li> <li>988 systems pilot, Central Coast – Not final. Andrea Tolaio has requested a meeting with NGA to discuss</li> <li>MOU is under review by state authorities.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Concerns from Centers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>worried about implementation, funding, and equipment, laptops have not been deployed – personal equipment have not been sent</li> <li>Inability to complete other work on 988 laptops/systems despite requirements communicated previously</li> <li>Inefficient systems, requirement for multiple computers will require budget renegotiation</li> </ul> </li> <li>Cal OES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The equipment has very particular requirements. May require a shared workspace with multiple computers.</li> <li>A Cal OES representative will attend the monthly meetings</li> </ul> </li> <li>There is a history of miscommunication and a need for AHP, as the new administrative entity, to proceed with clear coordination and communication</li> </ul>	Maja Jolly (AHP) for Cal OES

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Detailed feedback has been laid out – high level themes, changes to existing policies, generally comfortable, but concerns about staffing and expertise, feasibility, and speed of implementation</li> <li>Timelines and deadlines are not always aligning with what is feasible and realistic</li> </ul>
