One center is having difficulty with iCarol, specifically getting usable data. Are any centers using alternative platforms? Most centers seem to be using iCarol. 	
5	 Switching databases will be a really heavy lift. Optum uses its own internal system. Contra Costa uses Service Point. Buckelew uses GoTo connect. Felton Institute uses Salesforce and Zoom. A center is struggling to get chat/text data out of Vibrant unified system platform. Other centers are having the same issue. Didi Hirsch utilizes a monthly download from Vibrant to get access to data metrics needed for reporting. The data metrics can be downloaded here: Sign In · Vibrant Emotional Health. Monthly download login access can be requested through the Vibrant exchange. A center wants to use bilingual staff to support multiple language calls, bypass "press 2" for Spanish?
